



The Eileen Reilly Postgraduate Research Award: Terms and Conditions

- 1 grant of €500 will be awarded to the successful applicant.
- Applicants must be registered postgraduate students at an institution on the island of Ireland, or conducting research in Ireland pertaining to the Quaternary period.
- Applicants must be paid up members of IQUA for at least 6 months before applying for the award. If you are uncertain if you qualify for the award, please contact the IQUA Treasurer Mark Coughlan (mark.coughlan@icrag-centre.org).
- Applicants must provide a detailed description of their intended use of this award. Acceptable uses include: conference attendance, a training course, fieldwork, laboratory analysis. If you are not certain that your intended expense qualifies for the award, please contact the IQUA Secretary Graeme Swindles (g.swindles@qub.ac.uk).
- Applicants must provide a signature from their primary academic supervisor, establishing that their supervisor supports their application and their research.
- Applicants must send in their application by email to the IQUA Secretary Graeme Swindles (g.swindles@qub.ac.uk) before the due date or it will not be considered.
- Applicants will be required to either provide an article about their research for the IQUA newsletter, or to present their research at the annual IQUA Spring Symposium.
- The call for applications occurs in February every year. Applicants will be required to attend the annual IQUA spring meeting in March or April, where the winners will be officially announced.
